ILLUMINATOR & Project Governance

Problem

The client organisation comprises a number of business units which have been merged from previous structures or acquired from competitor companies within the sector. This diverse multi-business focused organisation has difficulties implementing common project governance across its many units and associated work-streams.

Solution


The first task from a governance perspective was to achieve a full understanding of the extent of practice diversity. This included an appraisal of all document and drawing repositories in use and an assessment of how project milestone objectives are measured and managed. It also required analysis of organisational communication practices, and specifically how governance notification and approval engagement is managed.

Graphical Data reviewed documentation requirements for a wide range of current and legacy projects. This involved analysis of documents associated with early design, detailed design, implementation, testing and project handover. We developed a common project governance workspace environment in ILLUMINATOR. Project milestone dashboards present at a glance progression tracking. Interfaces include API's to document repositories (e.g. Opentext Livelink, Microsoft Sharepoint), mail servers for notification and approval purposes and a comprehensive project performance reporting suite.


